Subject: Consider and act upon authorizing the City Manager to execute a Professional Services Agreement by and between the City of Frisco and STUDIO tla LLC. for the design services of Forest Bark Dog Park. (Engineering/NC)

Action Requested: Consider and act upon authorizing the City Manager to execute a Professional Services Agreement by and between the City of Frisco and STUDIO tla LLC. for the design services of Forest Bark Dog Park in the amount of \$587,500.00.

Background Information: Forest Bark Dog Park will be located in the southern portion of Harold Bacchus Community Park. The project would provide a state-of-the-art dog park servicing multiple nearby communities.

The design contract provides the City with basic services consisting of a conceptual plan for staff review, design development and preparation of permitting and construction documents for the park. The project will include an approximately three acre fenced dog park, interactive splash pad for dogs, new sidewalks and trails, park signage, lighting, irrigation, and an observation deck overlooking Panther Creek.

Financial Considerations: The Professional Services Agreement will be funded by the Community Development Corporation (CDC).

Legal Review: The Professional Services Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the City Attorney as to form and legality.

Alternatives: City Council could take the following actions.

- Authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement
- Deny authorizing the City Manager to execute the agreement
