Subject: Consider and act upon approval of a purchase order to Classic Chevrolet, Inc., for the purchase of twenty-five (25) vehicles for the Police Department. (Police/DF)

Action Requested: City Council approval of a purchase order to Classic Chevrolet, Inc., for the purchase of twenty-five (25) vehicles for the Police Department in the amount of \$1,275,350.

Background Information: The City of Frisco has an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Denton, City of Denton contract #7661. This purchase will provide for twenty-five (25) 2024 police pursuit Chevrolet Tahoes for the Police Department. All twenty-five (25) units are replacements for the Patrol Division fleet and were approved in the FY 2024 budget. Classic Chevrolet is unable to provide a date on when we will receive these vehicles, but they verified allocation of these units. Each unit costs \$51,014. This results in an overall request of \$1,275,350. Not included in this total is upfitting the vehicles which will be purchased by the Police Department on a separate contract.

Financial Considerations: Funding is available through the FY 2024 Police Department operating budget.

Alternatives: City Council could choose not to approve this purchase order at this time.
