Subject: Consider and act upon adoption of an Ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 2023-02-06 and designating eight (8) election precincts for the May 6, 2023 General Election and each election to be held in the City of Frisco, Collin and Denton Counties, Texas, thereafter, as ordered by the City Council. (CSO/KM)

Action Requested: City Council approve of an Ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 2023-02-06 and designating eight (8) election precincts for the May 6, 2023 General Election.

Background Information: In February 2023 the City Council designated eight (8) election precincts for the May 6, 2023 General Election. After these precincts were designated, Denton County Elections Administration notified the City that there were concerns regarding how many voters would be voting at Fire Station #7, which is located on Stonebrook Parkway. This was not due to the number of Frisco citizens assigned to this station, but due to the number of people from outside the Frisco City limits that needed to also vote at this particular station.

In the name of cooperation, the City agreed to move Denton County Precinct 1024 and 2081 to vote at Frisco Fire Station #4 which is located on Cotton Gin Road. This action will evenly disperse the number of citizens reporting to each polling location on election day and potentially reduce wait times for citizens.
